Letter from the President

Well another quarter has passed and your leadership team has been busy on several fronts. Let me first say welcome to spring for all us non-snowbirds. As you have probably heard by now, we are planning on have a 55th anniversary reunion in Washington, DC from June 6th- June 8th. There is probably a more detailed write -up elsewhere in this letter so I won't say too much here. We are still working on the specific activities and speaker(s). Our hope is that we will get in to see a Congressman or two while here in DC.

On March 8th, I was flown out to California to participate in a two and a half hour interview with Jocko Willink. He does a weekly Podcast and wanted to interview some Liberty veterans. Phil Tourney, Joe Meadors, and I went to San Diego for a couple days to be interviewed and then returned home. The Podcast is scheduled to air in late March or early April. This was a big deal in terms of the number of listeners he has.

I have been working with Congressman Pete McCloskey (retired) on a petition to have June 8th established as USS LIBERTY REMEMBRNCE DAY. The hope is to get signatures of candidates running for office along with other key people to add credibility to our request. I'm working it in Maryland now, but if anyone wants to do it in their state just contact me and I'll get you the forms.

The Liberty Veterans Association will soon be live streaming chats over the internet. We have purchased the rights to do streaming and Phil Tourney is working with industry partners to make sure we are setting things up correctly. I am anxious to see how well that goes and how large an audience we can glean.

We are still looking for family members and other interested folks who might want to step up and help out in a volunteer status. We need people to take on some LVA leadership roles as well as helping out on reunion plans. June 6th is just around the corner so please speak up if you can help. I look forward to seeing many of you in June which is only three months away.

Statement of Purpose

IN JUNE 1967 jet aircraft and motor torpedo boats of the Defense Forces of the State of Israel brutally assaulted the American naval intelligence-gathering ship, USS *Liberty*, while in international waters off the coast of the Sinai Peninsula in the Mediterranean Sea. The attack was preceded by more than six hours of intense low-level surveillance by Israeli photo reconnaissance aircraft, which buzzed the ship as low as 200 feet directly overhead. The carefully orchestrated assault that followed was initiated by high performance jet aircraft. This was followed by slower and more maneuverable jets carrying na-



palm, and was finally turned over to lethal torpedo boats, which blasted a forty-foot hole in the ship's side. The attack lasted more than two hours, deliberately killing 34 Americans and wounding at least 171 others. Over 821 rocket, cannon and machine gun holes were inflicted. When the Liberty stubbornly remained afloat despite her damage, Israeli forces machine-gunned her life rafts, firefighters, stretcher bearers, and sent helicopters carrying troops to finish the job, no survivors were to be taken.

At this point, with Sixth Fleet rescue aircraft supposedly en route, the government of Israel apologized and the identity of the assailants became known.

Details of the attack were hushed up in both countries. Israel claimed that her forces mistook the Liberty for an Egyptian ship, and our government quietly accepted that excuse despite evidence to the contrary. No ship in our history has ever received such damage and casualties by accident. Then our government downplayed the intensity of the surveillance and the severity of the attack, and imposed a news blackout on the crew to keep the story under control. The official version is that the *Liberty* was reconnoitered only three times and only from a great distance. The American people were told that the air attack lasted only five minutes and that it was followed by a single torpedo and an immediate apology and offer of assistance. Nothing could be further from the truth. In June 1982, fifteen years after the assault, crewmembers reunited for the first time in Washington, D.C. It was a tearful, joyful reunion in which the men not only released their pent up emotions and decided that the **USS Liberty Veterans Association** would be formed with the firm goals of finding all crew members, holding reunions, proper recognition of Captain and crew (in particular those who lost their lives), obtaining a Congressional investigation into the attack, and...

LCDR Armstrong at Michigan Heroes Museum



"LCdr. Philip M. Armstrong, USN, executive officer in USS LIBERTY, was killed when the ship was mistakenly attacked by Israeli forces on 8 June in the Mediterranean. Services were held from the Twiford Funeral Home, Virginia Beach, Va., with interment in Arlington National Cemetery with military honors on 16 June.

LCdr. Armstrong, who was born in Detroit, Mich., enlisted in the U. S. Navy in July 1947, and served with Patrol Squadron 23, Naval Air Station, Patuxent River, before entering the Naval Academy Preparatory School at Bainbridge, Md. He was graduated from the Naval Academy in 1953 and served in the destroyer escort MCCAFFERY until June 1955 when he joined the landing ship FORT SNELLING.

In February 1958 he was transferred to the staff of the Commandant, Third Naval District in New York, then had duty in USS BETELGEUSE. He served in the Bureau of Naval Personnel for two years, then on the staff of Commander Naval Beach Group Two for operations and plans. In March 1966 he was assigned to the LIBERTY.

Surviving are his widow Marie and five children, Philip M., III, Timothy B., Christopher M., Katherine K. and Elizabeth R. of 131 Cayuga Road, Virginia Beach, Va. 23462; his father, Mr. Philip M. Armstrong of Detroit, three brothers, Thomas, John, and Christopher, and a sister Marjorie Armstrong."
